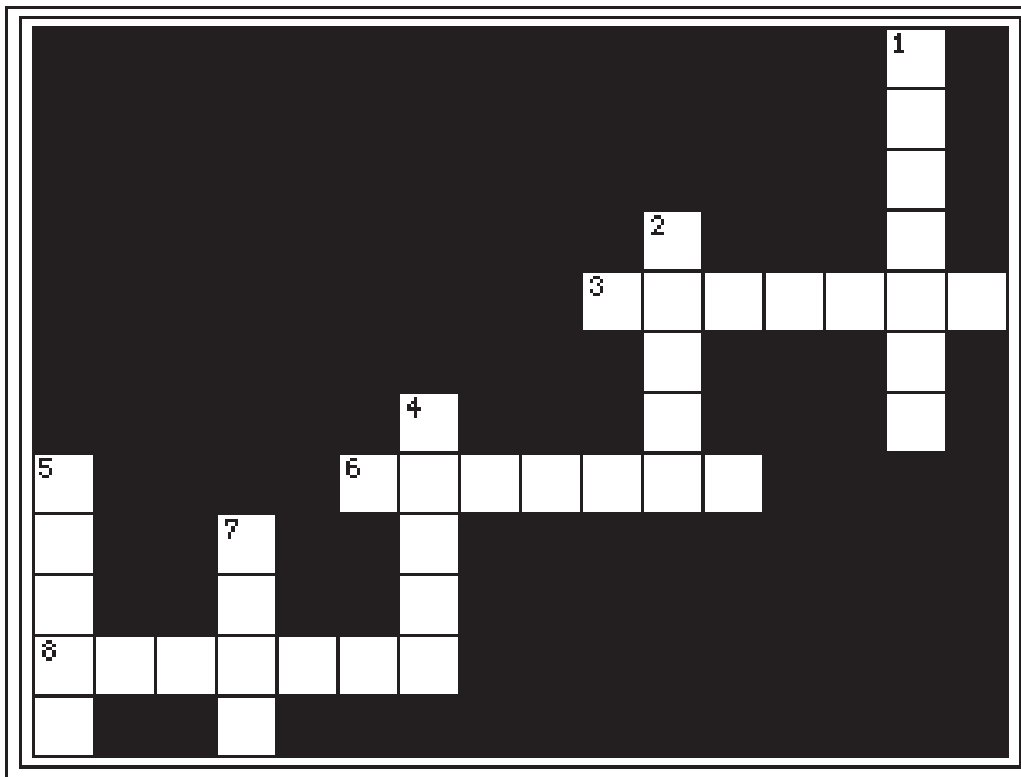


RUTH GLEANS IN THE FIELD
