The Capital Campaign Committee met November 16 to study proposals from three different lighting contractors. All of the contractors have noted that having a lighter colored ceiling in our worship space would make any lighting enhancements more effective. With the impact of ceiling color on lighting design, the committee has begun to solicit proposals from painting contractors for painting/staining the ceiling a lighter color, possibly similar to that done in the mid-1990s on the vertical walls above the side overhangs. With this representing a significant change to our worship space the committee felt it best to seek input from the broader membership. It is anticipated that refined painting and lighting proposals will be available for consideration in January. Proposals for audio-video equipment to stream worship for those not able to attend are also being sought.
