## BABY CARE KITS

May means Mother's Day and the start of Baby Care Kits at Our Savior's. The items you collect help a baby get off to a good start in life with basic baby care supplies.



Bringing a baby into the world can be a difficult and scary thing for a mother living in poverty. She worries about her baby's health and well-being when there is a lack of money to buy the things every mother wants for her newborn.

The items included in a baby care kit provide the things a mother needs to care for her baby the way she hopes to – soft blankets to give warmth and comfort, soap to keep the germs away. Lack of something to dress her baby in often keeps a mother isolated from her community, but the clothes in a baby care kit welcome both mother and baby out into the world.

### EACH BABY CARE KIT SHOULD INCLUDE:

**TWO** lightweight cotton t-shirts (no Onesies®), **TWO** long- or short-sleeved gowns or sleepers (without feet), **TWO** receiving blankets, medium-weight cotton or flannel, or crocheted or knitted with lightweight yarn, between 36" and 52" square, **FOUR** cloth diapers, flat fold preferred, **ONE** jacket, sweater, or sweatshirt with a hood, or include a baby cap, **TWO** pairs of socks, **ONE** hand towel, dark color recommended, **TWO** or three bath-size bars of gentle soap equaling 8 to 9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping; please no mini or hotel size bars, and **TWO** diaper pins or large safety pins

### SOME IMPORTANT GUIDELINES TO REMEMBER

There are a few handmade baby sweaters at church to help complete your kit. Gently used, clean items (no stains or tears) can be substituted for new ones. Please wrap the items in one of the receiving blankets, secure with the diaper pins, and return to church for shipping.
