# CONGREGATIONAL MEETING TO APPROVE FINAL UPDATE TO OUR WELCOME STATEMENT Sunday, May 7, 2023 Following Worship

When I submitted our new Welcome Statement to Reconciling works, they applauded our changes, but pointed out an error made when we added "gender identity" to our Welcome.

# We need to add two more words. The statement ought to include "gender expression."

We will have a congregational meeting May 7<sup>th</sup> after worship to vote on this final update. If approved, our statement will be good to use and we will be able to continue as an RIC congregation.

These little updates to the statement might seem trivial, or unnecessary. The truth is, harassment of the LGBTQ+ community is on the increase. States are revoking policies of inclusion... the state of Florida passed a "Don't Say Gay" bill. The state of lowa banned gender affirming care for youth. The WI legislature blocked a ban on conversion therapy. These measures (and myriad others) haunt members of the LGBTQ community. We need to be clear in our words and in our deeds: all are welcome at Our Savior's.

### Our new Welcome Statement would read:

All are welcome in this church! The Good News of God's grace is for all, regardless of age, abilities, physical & mental health, race, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, education, income or strength of faith. There is nothing we do, have done or will do that can separate us from the love of God. God makes no exceptions, nor do we. Come join us in praise, prayer and the work of our Lord, including ongoing work for racial equity in our Church and in the world.
