

I mentioned in a sermon recently, I traveled to Chicago for a few days last month. I will be going again in August. Here's why:

After a series of tests and phone conversations, I have been accepted to participate in a medical research study run by the Michael J. Fox Foundation for Parkinson's Research. My first trip to Chicago was to participate in the last tests before my acceptance, which were some lab work and a brain scan.

The Parkinson's Progression Markers Initiative studies how brain disease starts and changes and how it might be stopped. Participants commit to a five year involvement; each year I will travel to a study center (Chicago) for cognitive and motor skills assessment, a brain scan, an MRI, skin sampling testing, and a lumbar puncture to examine my spinal fluid.

I do not have Parkinson's Disease. I have friends who do. When I discovered I might be a candidate for this study, I jumped at the chance. My mother participated in two different medical studies when she was younger. She set a good example.

There are a variety of ways to serve the gospel. This is one. Being a tiny part of a research project that is already changing the world's knowledge of a horrendous disease answers God's call to love one another as God loves us. This is a way I can help make life better for all those at risk of a Parkinson's Disease diagnosis.
