SOME IMPORTANT GUIDELINES TO REMEMBER

- Please include sizes between 6 and 24 months. Varying the sizes of the clothing items included will make the Kit useful as the baby grows.
- Gently used, clean clothing and blankets (no stains or tears) may be substituted
 for new ones. It is especially important that the items be in excellent condition, as
 used clothing is increasingly difficult to get through customs in many countries.
 Even one item that looks worn or stained to local officials can jeopardize the status of a whole shipment. All other items in the kit must be new.
- Please do not donate items with any religious symbols, messages, or your group's name.
- Please do not donate any items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic, or military symbols, or references to the armed forces, including camouflage.
- Do not add other items or leave out any of the items listed.
- Do not enclose the kit or any of its contents in plastic bags.
