- ☐ **FOUR** cloth diapers, flat fold preferred
- ☐ **ONE** hand towel, dark color recommended
- ☐ **TWO** diaper pins or large safety pins
- ☐ **ONE** jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with a hood, or include a baby cap
- ☐ **TWO** or three bath-size bars of gentle soap equaling 8 to 9 oz.
