3—FOSTER & RESPITE CARE NEEDED IN LA CROSSE COUNTY

Greetings from La Crosse County Foster Care,

There is a greater need than ever for foster homes in La Crosse County. In recent months, we have faced heartbreaking circumstances that required separating sibling groups and placing children in foster homes outside of the county due to lack of foster homes. These placements make it more difficult for children to remain connected to their parents, schools, neighbors, and other vital supports within their community.

As you might expect, we make every effort to avoid these outcomes. Unfortunately, the shortage of available foster homes has limited our ability to meet the needs of the vulnerable children entering care. For this reason, we are reaching out to invite you to consider becoming a foster parent for La Crosse County. By doing so, you can help keep siblings together and allow children to remain close to home during a critical time in their lives.

If fostering is not an option for your family, there are still meaningful ways to help. One option is to become a respite provider. Respite families support foster parents by caring for children on weekends or during short periods when foster families need temporary assistance.



